Contractors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • work with contractors who are equally as committed to reducing their environmental impact.

Energy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we are committed to producing and consuming energy from renewable sources including our own solar panels • Lights and electrical equipment will be switched off when not in use to reduce energy consumption.
Waste management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we will reduce the amount of waste produced and recycle where possible. • we will prevent the release of pollutants that can cause environmental damage (if relevant).
Office supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we will evaluate the environmental impact of any new products we intend to purchase.
Maintenance and office cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the cleaning materials we use will be checked to ensure they are as environmentally friendly as possible.
Our people	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we will involve staff in the implementation of this policy, for greater commitment and improved performance.
Water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we will avoid water wastage wherever possible.
Chemicals and hazardous substances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • wherever possible we will substitute substances that are harmful to the environment with those that have less of an impact.
